COMPONENTS OF RESEARCH PROBLEM There must be an individual or a group which has some difficulty. There must be some objective(s) to be attained at.If one wants nothing,one cannot have a problem. There must be alternative means (or the courses of action) for attaining the objectives one wish to attain.This means that there must be at least two means available to a researcher for if he has no choice of means,he cannot have a problem. There must remain some doubt in the mind of a researcher ...
